**CONTRACT TERMS**

The undersigned understands and agrees to abide by the following terms and conditions:

- Show hours are Friday, October 30, 6 – 8 PM, Saturday, October 31, 10 AM to 4 PM, and Sunday, November 1, 10 AM to 4 PM. Set-up time is 8 AM to 5 PM on Friday, October 30. Exhibitors must be clear of the building by 7 PM on Sunday, November 1.
- Antique Dealers and Vintage Quilt & Fiber Arts dealers will be subject to usual guidelines of quality antique shows. Contemporary Quilt & Fiber Art shops and artists will present their best merchandise for sale.
- Show Management reserves the right to inspect all displays. Exhibitors must remove any items management considers inappropriate. Booth sharing is not permitted unless permission is received from the dealer chairman in advance. Show Management reserves the right to assign or reassign booth space.
- Exhibitor badges should be picked up on Friday and worn Friday, Saturday and Sunday. There will be two badges issued per exhibitor. Extra badges will be furnished upon request of the dealer chairman, in advance.
- Exhibits and equipment must be confined within the assigned space. All tables must be draped to the floor, with flame retardant material, unless items are displayed under the table. Booths may be divided by walls or tall furnishing and draped. Electric outlets are available to the booths, and dealer extension cords must be heavy duty. No nails are to be put in the walls, tables or screens by the exhibitors. ONLY Painter's Masking Tape may be used on the gymnasium floor. NO SMOKING IS PERMITTED IN THE SCHOOL BUILDING NOR ON THE GROUNDS!! The exhibitors shall comply with all state, county and local fire regulations.
- Overnight security is provided on Friday and Saturday evenings.
- Exhibitors shall indemnify WQHP, Inc. and/or its members or employees from and against any claim, loss, theft, or damage to antiques, quilts, property, liability or personal injury, including attorney's fees, while participating in the Antiques, Quilts & Fiber Arts Show & Sale.
